Semester system is followed for the BA programme under CBCS (Choice Based Credit System). Students are offered BA in a core subject along with a number of generative electives, discipline specific electives and ability enhancing papers. Students choose their core paper in the first semester itself and continue with core paper up to the final semester. Students are given freedom to select various elective papers and ability - enhancing papers along with core subject during the course of three years.

ELIGIBILITY

Pass with at least 45% of marks in class XII of the CBSE or an equivalent examination recognized by RGU. Pass in compulsory English in Class XII is a must.

- 3. Admission shall be on the date notified in the date notified admit card.
- 4. Admission procedure on the day of Admission:
 - (a) Campus Briefing, (b) Personal Interaction, (c) Meeting with Principal,
 - (d) Submission of Original documents &
- (e) Payment of Fees.
